



## Request to Ship a POV Outbound

- e. Catalytic converters, catalyst components ( pellets) oxygen sensors or pipe segments used to replace converters in overseas areas.

**The above loose such items can be shipped as long as they can be contained entirely within the shipping inventory box provided by your Transcar agent. Box size: L 24" W 16" H 13"**

**VEHICLES DESTINED FOR GUAM OR HAWAII** Nothing may remain in the trunk except one spare tire with wheel and minimum tools as explained in paragraph a - above.

The shipment of flammable or hazardous material, including flares, oils, waxes, solvents and polishes is highly prohibited and **MUST** be removed prior to turn-in

**CLEANLINESS OF THE POV:**

The interior and exterior of the POV must be free from dirt, soil, mud etc., Please clean both the inside and outside of you POV. You should also insure that the area under the hood is free of leaves etc.

All garbage, personal effects etc., must be removed from the vehicle. Only items as listed above will be allowed to remain inwith the POV during shipment.

**GAS Level:**

U.S. Coast Guard Regulations stipulate that your POV should contain one fourth( 1/4 ) tank of GAS or **LESS**. The VPC does not have the facility to drain**Tax Free Gas**.

**MISCELLANEOUS:**

If your POV has a butane or propane tank **IT MUST BE EMPTY** You will need to have the tank certified as empty by your local Fire Department. The Fire Department will issue a sticker to this effect. This **MUST** be accomplished prior to acceptance of your POV for shipment.

**Before Turn-In**

Insure that your POV has both **EPA** and **DOT** labels, if not obtain written confirmation from the manufacturer that your POV was manufactured to meet the standards in effect at time of manufacture.
